Important Guidelines for Students Appearing for the SAT Exam – Saturday, 3rd October 2026

1. Entry and Check-in

- The school gate will open and check-in will begin at **7:15 a.m.**
- Check-in will close promptly at **7:45 a.m.** Students are requested to arrive well in advance to complete the entry formalities. Late arrivals may not be permitted to enter the testing rooms. **The exam will end by 10:45 am.**

2. Mandatory Documents

Students must carry the following documents to be allowed entry into the testing rooms:

- **Physical copy of SAT Admission Ticket**
- **Original and valid Photo ID:** Students must carry one of the following acceptable forms of identification:
 - **Passport:** Original, physical and unexpired passport bearing the student's full legal name, photograph and signature.
 - **Aadhaar Card:** Aadhaar PVC Card with your name and photograph. Only the letter and PVC Card forms of Aadhaar ID are valid. The letter must be hard copy format as issued by the government of India in its original form
 - **U.S. Global Entry Card or UNHCR Card**
 - **Common Access Card (CAC)**

Please note: Digital IDs, photocopies, printouts or any electronic documents displayed on mobile phones or other devices will not be accepted. Students must carry the original physical documents.

3. Stationery, Water and Food

- Students must carry their own laptop with pre-installed bluebook, permitted calculator, power backup, No. 2 Pencil, a Sharpener & eraser. No sharing will be allowed. All stationery needs to be kept in transparent pouch.
- Students may carry water in **transparent water bottles only.**
- Students may also bring food during the scheduled break. Food must be kept securely packed and consumed only during the permitted break.

4. Discipline and Conduct

- Students are expected to maintain discipline and conduct themselves appropriately while entering and moving around the school premises.
- Any act of indiscipline, disruptive behaviour or non-compliance with instructions from school staff may result in disciplinary action.
- Students must follow all instructions given by the school staff and SAT examination personnel at all times.
- Students can come in casual attire.

5. Entry to the School Premises

- Entry to the school premises and testing rooms will be subject to verification of the required documents and compliance with the examination guidelines.
- The school reserves the right to deny entry to anyone who does not meet the stipulated requirements.
